Babies, Books and Bubbles: This program is a free drop-in, however, we do require tokens for admission. Tokens will be available at the Children's Room desk on a first-come, first-served basis starting at 9:00 am on the day of the program and will be available until they run out (and/or the program has already begun). Every participant must have a token for admission. Enjoy songs, fingerplays and books with the littlest listeners. Babies from birth to 2 are welcome, along with their caregivers. Come for the stories and songs, stay for the bubbles and toys!

Yoga for Preschoolers: Sharing yoga with children helps them to get in touch with themselves and to learn to trust their instincts. It acknowledges and nurtures their special gifts and strengths. The children will experience fun, playfulness and collaboration with others in the learning process. For children age 4-6 (and their partners!). Registration starts two weeks before the date of each session. This program is sponsored by the Friends of the Shrewsbury Public Library.

Preschool French: Join us for a special program! A very casual approach to learning French for preschoolers (age 3-6) AND their caregivers.

The program will run for 30-45 minutes. This is a drop in program, no registration required.

Read to a Dog programs are a wonderful way to encourage reluctant readers or children who need to practice their independent reading skills, especially those who love being with dogs! Volunteers and dogs are trained and certified in a pet therapy program provided by Paws for People - a non-profit organization associated with the Cummings School of Veterinary Medicine at Tufts University. Owner and dog scheduled for today: Margaret and Scout. This program is for children who can already read. Registration is required.

Please note: Due to the complexities of scheduling a dog's visit to the library, the program must have a minimum of 3 participating readers. In the event that registrations do not meet this requirement, the program will be cancelled. Cancellations will be posted in red at the top above.
